Before the tents were packed away on Trade Secrets® 2019, the planning for 2020 had already begun. The 20th Anniversary! The excitement quickly built as plans took shape. As staff members and volunteers began to pour over photos and memorabilia from the previous two decades, the tremendous impact of what had begun as a simple plant sale at the home of Bunny Williams and John Rosselli, became clear. This was no ordinary fundraiser.

With the passing of Elaine La Roche last August, the event took on new significance. Trade Secrets 2020 was to be the last year at LionRock Farm and everyone wanted the importance of the event and the history of its evolution to be reflected. From a small-scale fundraiser to a renowned destination event, attracting travelers from around the globe, Trade Secrets is something special.

At the end of last winter, as program staff and volunteers entered the busiest period of Trade Secrets preparation, it all came to a screeching halt.

The gravity of the COVID-19 pandemic struck us full force. We made the difficult but necessary decision to cancel Trade Secrets 2020. As Women's Support Services pivoted to ensure client support and safety, we faced the daunting task of dismantling a beloved event - and an event that was a major source of funding for our work.

In the midst of this upheaval, what happened next was an incredible testament to the concept of *community*.
